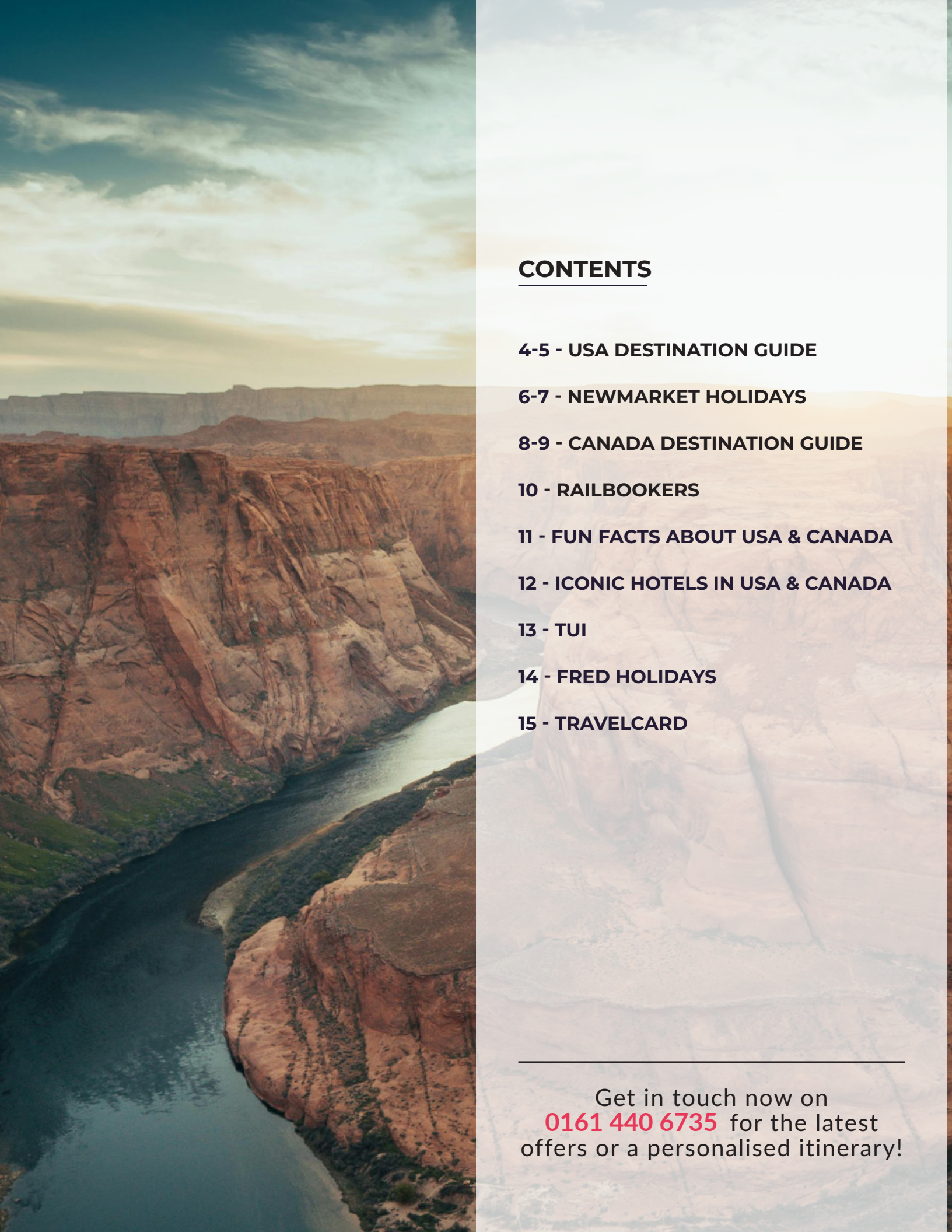

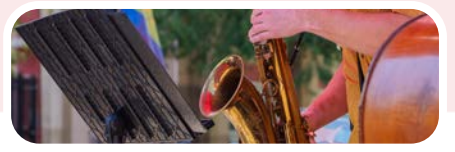
GRACELAND

DISNEY CALIFORNIA

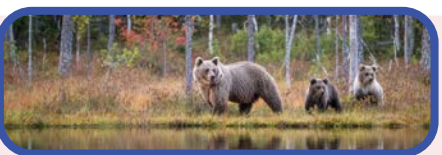
The first Disney park ever built. It has 9 theme rides and is just 27 miles from downtown LA

Toronto

Probably the most famous city in Canada, sitting on the edge of Lake Ontario. Enjoy spectacular views from the CN Tower, visit the historic castle style mansion of Casa Loma or take a boat ride for views of the city skyline and access to the beaches and parks dotted along the lakeside. The famous Niagara Falls is a popular day excursion. You can combine it with a trip to the rugged Niagara Glen Nature Reserve



Vancouver

Quebec City

The capital of French speaking Quebec Province and sitting on the St. Lawrence River, visitors to Quebec City can immerse themselves in 400 years of history by exploring the UNESCO-listed Old Quebec (Vieux-Québec), walking the Plains of Abraham, and visiting the iconic Fairmont Le Château Frontenac



Halifax

The Provincial capital of Nova Scotia (New Scotland) on Canada East Coast, visitors to Halifax can explore the historic waterfront boardwalk, tour the hilltop Citadel National Historic Site, and stroll through the Victorian-era Public Gardens. Top activities include visiting the Maritime Museum of the Atlantic, taking a boat tour, and taking a day trip to the iconic Peggy's Cove lighthouse



Calgary

Alberta; Visitors to Calgary can experience a mix of urban culture and natural beauty, including iconic spots like the Calgary Tower, Heritage Park Historical Village and the TELUS Science Centre. Its most famous event the Calgary Stampede takes place every summer. This 10-day event features parade, rodeos and music festivals – book early to avoid disappointment

"Polar Bear Capital of the World"; the best place to see polar bears in the wild, along with beluga whales and the Northern Lights



VANCOUVER ISLAND

Famous for marine life, including orcas, humpback whales, seals, and sea lions. Clayoquot Sound is excellent for black bear viewing



BANFF & JASPER

Iconic for Rocky Mountain wildlife, including elk, bighorn sheep, mountain goats, grizzly bears, and black bears, especially along the Icefields Parkway

QUEBEC CITY

Combines classic French cuisine with local Québécois dishes (like meat pie and poutine) in a historic setting



OKANAGAN VALLEY

A top destination for wine lovers, featuring numerous vineyards and winery restaurants like Mission Hill



CHARLOTTETOWN

Known for its oysters, mussels, and fresh ice cream, particularly at the farmers' markets

A world-renowned luxury service operating strictly during daylight hours to ensure amazing views

The longest-running named passenger train in North America, connecting Montreal and Halifax
